

Paper on the back

or

Getting to know each other if I think you know each other

The tool is used to start a course or seminar when some of the participants already know each other. It is a funny way to guess what people are up to and what they like.

Ca. 20-30 min

Material: flipchart, paper, pen and sticky tape

Description:

- 1. Each person gets a sheet of paper stuck on their back.**
- 2. The flipchart shows 3-5 suggestions of questions.**
3. For example: What food does the person like? Which is her/his favorite part? Where did she/he go for her last holidays? What did she/he want to be when she/he was a child? How does the house of hers/his dreams look like? ...
4. While walking around, everybody gets a pen and writes the answers he/she thinks could be right on the papers stuck to the backs. Be a bit creative.
- 5. After 15-20 min stop writing, sit down in a circle and take the paper of your back.**
- 6. Now each person can comment on the ideas and suggestions made on the sheet of paper towards oneself.**
